Home Invasion/Homicide 1837 Clinton Avenue

At 8:51 pm on Thursday March 21, 2019 Berwyn Police responded to calls from citizens regarding a male subject on the 1800 block of Clinton Avenue bleeding from his mouth and stating he had been robbed. Officers located a 19 year old male victim who related that three armed offenders had entered his home at 1837 S. Clinton Avenue, separated him from his stepfather by putting him in the basement at which time he jumped out of a window and ran to neighbors for help. The 19 year old victim related the three offenders were still inside the home and that his father was possibly unconscious.

Berwyn Officers made entry into the first floor of the bungalow and found an unidentified male subject approximately 50 years of age, unconscious and bleeding within the residence. No offenders were located with the residence. Berwyn Officers began providing medical treatment to the subject until Berwyn Paramedics arrived on the scene and transported the subject to Loyola Medical Center in Maywood. The subject later died from his injuries. The subject has been identified as 57 year old Juan Torres of 1837 S. Clinton Ave. The deceased victim was transported to the Cook County Medical Examiner's Office where an autopsy is scheduled for later today.

Berwyn Police have canvassed the area for leads and Berwyn Police Detectives are actively working this investigation. The WESTAF (West Suburban Major Crimes Task Force) forensics team was called in to assist with evidence collection and processing of the crime scene. This incident does not appear to be random and the Citizens at large are not in any danger at this time.

Berwyn Police Detectives are working on offender descriptions and that information will be released as soon as it becomes available.
